RE: Complaint Against Committee ID: 13544 (If you absolutely, positively, one hundred percent want to put felons in prison its mandatory that you vote yes on 61, ...)

To whom it may concern:

Steve Doell, Treasurer of Political Committee 13544, created on September 30, 2008, has failed to report any contributions and expenditures for the 2008 General Election. Per Oregon law, transaction reporting is required within 7 days between the 42<sup>nd</sup> day before the election and Election Day. This has not occurred.

On October 1, 2008, CommonSense for Oregon PAC (Committee ID: 13471, Treasurer Ross A Day) made a cash expenditure of \$456,150.00 to this committee yet it has not been reported.


In addition, the committee has aired commercials on KXL Radio since the first few days of October and perhaps sooner. The time and costs required to produce a radio spot usually precede an airing date by several days. Normally, political ads on radio and TV are paid for in advance.

I believe there are other unreported contributions and expenditures. It's also quite possible this committee was active under Oregon law long before its filing. As an example, the committee should have filed sooner if it had "a pledge to make a contribution" longer than three business days prior to its filing on Tuesday, September 30, 2008.

I seek the maximum civil penalties accorded under Oregon law for violations that have occurred. I believe these violations constitute an intentional "culture of deception and misreporting."

I also seek investigation of the financial interactions between "If you absolutely, positively,....," "CommonSense for Oregon PAC," "Oregon Anti-Crime Alliance PAC," and Loren Parks in regard to Parks initial contribution of \$500,000 to the latter committee since it obscured from the public where the funding of "If you absolutely, positively,...." was coming from. There may be other violations.
